



### Q. 4. Answer in one word. (Mention name of medicine)

- (a) Ears: chronic otitis; discharge purulent, like putrid meat; granulations, condylomata; polypi, pale red, cellular, bleeding easily.
- (b) Sneezing, especially when entering a warm room. Copious, watery & extremely acrid nasal discharge.
- (c) Ulcer on cornea. Iritis, with pus in anterior chamber, purulent conjunctivitis, with marked chemosis, profuse discharge, great sensitiveness to touch and air, better by heat and cover.
- (d) First stage of ulceration of cornea. Cornea like ground grass. Oily tears.
- (e) Name 2 remedies Ophthalmia neonatorum.
